PURPOSE

Designing effective online courses takes time, effort, and support. The **GMCTL Course Design and Development Fund** helps faculty move teaching forward by supporting projects that enhance course quality and align with [USask's Teaching Strategies](#).

Funds may be used to hire a **Subject Matter Expert (SME)** or provide **teaching release** for faculty to focus on developing impactful learning materials **in collaboration with an instructional designer (ID)**.



FUNDING AND PARAMETERS

Funding	Up to \$9,000 per project (based on scope)
Timeline	Projects must be completed within 6 months of start date.
Phased Funding	Payment released in 3 stages
Support	Funds will support courses that: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• are for credit (min. 3 credit units)• impact many students over time and/or multiple programs• are sustainable (3-5 years without major revision)• advance one or more of USask's Teaching Strategies
